Bill Analysis

SB 1308 provides that if a person who sells or offers to sell merchandise or a service for any specified period under a contract containing a provision for automatic renewal then he or she must present the terms of the automatic renewal offer in proximity to the offer in a clear and conspicuous manner, provide an acknowledgement that includes the terms of the automatic renewal offer and how to cancel the renewal, and provide a cost-effective and simple method of cancellation. Persons who sell such merchandise or services for a period of 6 months shall also provide a clear and conspicuous written notice to the purchaser stating that the purchaser may cancel the contract and avoid automatic renewal. Any contract violating the provisions of this measure shall be void and unenforceable. The Attorney General may enforce the provisions of this measure and any person aggrieved by a violation may bring an action for restitution and injunctive relief.
