Bill Analysis

SB 1327 provides that a firearm suppressor manufactured in the state and remaining in the state shall not be subject to federal law or federal regulation. Basic materials used in the manufacture of such suppressors shall not be considered a suppressor and not subject to federal regulation. Suppressors manufactured in the state shall have "Made in Oklahoma" clearly stamped on them. A firearm shall be considered manufactured in the state if it does not import parts, other than generally insignificant parts, into the state and is manufactured in the state from basic materials. The measure preempts any municipal or county regulation of suppressors and prohibits any person employed by or otherwise under the direction or control of a municipality or other political subdivision from enforcing any federal statute, ordinance, rule, or regulation contrary to the provisions of this measure. No municipality or subdivision shall receive funding from the state if it violates the provisions of this measure.
