Bill Analysis

The CS for SB 1352 creates the Oklahoma Consumer Energy Choice Act. The measure prohibits any town, city, or county from adopting an ordinance, rule, or code which limits consumer access to an energy source or de facto prohibits a wholesaler, retailer, or the related infrastructure providing consumer access to a specific energy source within the jurisdiction of a city, town, or county. The measure also declares any limitation of consumer access to an energy source by any city, town, county, or subdivision as a statewide concern and prohibits such limitations.
