## **Bill Analysis**

SB 1446 defines coercive control within the Domestic Abuse Act to include intentionally isolating a family or household member; intentional deprivation of necessities; controlling movements; compelling a member by force, threat, or intimidation; committing or threatening to commit cruelty to an animal; forced sex acts or threats of a sexual nature; and making demands on a family or household member which limits free will and leads to compliance. Domestic abuse shall include instances of coercive control.
