**Bill Analysis**

SB 1463 provides that if a state agency accepts a services type of contract, it must list the city, state, and country in which the services will be prepared and produced. Work that the state awards to a company that is not strictly awarded by the lowest price as well as to a company not based in the state shall require the awarding agency's director to provide reasons why the services are not prepared and produced in Oklahoma.
