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**Bill Analysis**

SB 1515 provides that a certified emergency medical response agency may provide limited transport in an emergency vehicle as defined in current statute after receiving the approval of appropriate medical control at the time of transport. Emergency transportation shall not be required if a patient's apparent clinical condition does not warrant emergency ambulance transport. Non-transport protocols as the relate to patients must be authorized by the regional medical director.

**House Amendments**

HA's to the measure adds language requiring emergency vehicles as defined in current statute to be used when providing limited transport.
