Bill Analysis

SB 1515 provides that a certified emergency medical response agency may provide limited transport after receiving the approval of appropriate medical control at the time of transport. The measure also provides that transportation to medical facilities shall not be the choice of the patient if an event identified by the appropriate medical control as a local, regional, or national emergency occurs. Emergency transportation shall not be required if a patient's apparent clinical condition does not warrant emergency ambulance transport. Non-transport protocols as the relate to patients must be authorized by the regional medical director.
