Bill Analysis

SB 1538 provides that any person who disobeys orders from a peace officer during the course of the officer's duties shall be subject to a term of imprisonment in the county jail for a term not to exceed 6 months and a fine not to exceed \$500.00. The measure also provides that any person who knowingly, willfully, and with intent to do bodily harm, commits any assault, battery or assault and battery, aggravated assault and battery or any assault with a firearm or other deadly weapon upon a firemen shall be deemed to have committed a felony on conviction.
