Bill Analysis

SB 1573 modifies the list of preclusions for a person to be licensed or to carry a firearm under the Oklahoma Self Defense Act. The measure requires persons who had previously undergone treatment for a mental illness that required supervision or medication, persons with 2 or more convictions of public intoxication, persons with 2 or more convictions related to driving while intoxicated, as well as persons who underwent inpatient treatment for substance abuse to obtain a certified statement from a licensed physician specializing in mental health or substance abuse treatment before the preclusion period can end.
