**Bill Analysis**

SB 1583 allows the parent or legal guardian of a student enrolled in a resident district that has received an “F” overview grade through the accountability system in the immediately preceding school year to request a transfer allowance for the student to enroll in a private school. The measure requires the State Department of Education to approve private schools in which students may enroll. The bill directs the Department to calculate the transfer allowance based on the amount of State Aid for which the eligible student qualifies and provides a process for the State Board of Education to deny, suspend, or revoke approval of a private school.
