## **Bill Analysis**

SB 163 modifies language relating to city-county libraries. The measure allows a library commission to meet as often as required, rather than once each month and requires the income of city-county library systems to be deposited in a city-county library commission account in a bank whose deposits are insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation and removes language specifying how such funds are to be used. The measure also removes language requiring a city governing body and a board of county commissioners to approve a resolution prior to a city-county library accepting interests in real property. City-county library commissions may borrow on the credit of the commission for up to 1 year. The measure removes language requiring a city governing body and a board of county commissioners to approve a city-county library commission for up to 1 year.
