**Bill Analysis**

SB 1737 requires all medical marijuana commercial grower licensees who operate an outdoor medical marijuana production facility to register with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry as an environmentally sensitive crop owner beginning November 1, 2022. Medical marijuana commercial grower licensees shall also provide their business name, address, Global Positioning System (GPS) coordinates for all outdoor medical marijuana production facilities, and any other information required by the Department when registering with the Environmentally Sensitive Area Registry. Additionally, all medical marijuana commercial grower licensees shall be required to post signage as outlined in the measure at the site of the commercial grow operation.

**CCR Changes**

The Conference Committee Report for SB 1737 completely substitutes engrossed language with the language described above.
