Bill Analysis

SB 1782 modifies the time allowed between the submission of an application and the effective date of an agreement by reducing it from 24 months to 12 months as it relates to the Quality Jobs Program Act. The measure requires establishments to pay both on the effective date of the agreement and at the beginning of the 6th year of the agreement new direct jobs an average annualized wage which equals or exceeds the amounts outlined in current law. The measure also increases the minimum wage requirements to equal the greater of the average county or average state wage, and it eliminates the maximum wage threshold.
