Bill Analysis

SB 1821 authorizes a charitable organization to host a wagering event if the organization requires attendants to be 18 years of age or older, hosts the event in a location designated for use by an organization subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma Charity Games Act, cumulative winnings and prizes do not exceed \$1,000.00, conducts it as a 1-day event, prohibits absentee betting, did not promote the event in certain locations, require individuals to report their winnings, and the organization reports individuals who win more than \$1,000.00 per quarter. The measure directs the Oklahoma Tax Commission to promulgate rules and forms needed to carry out the provisions of this measure. Certain games are prohibited by the measure. The measure also authorizes individuals to private host wagering events if everyone in attendance is 18 years of age or older, the host does not profit from the event, total cash prizes do not exceed \$1,000.00, individuals at the event may not wager more than \$100.00 per individual, the event lasts only 1 day, the event was not advertised in certain locations, and income from the event is properly reported.
