Bill Analysis

The FS for SB 186 restores the right to a person who has been convicted of a non-violent felony in a court of the state, tribal court, or court of the United States to carry a firearm 5 years after completion of the sentence for the last felony offense if no additional charges are pending against the person. The measure strikes language prohibiting any felon from riding in a vehicle with a firearm in the vehicle. Additionally, the measure strikes obsolete language relating to handgun licenses. The FS also modifies the term “altered toy pistol” to require the toy pistol to be more dangerous or powerful than the original design.
