**Bill Analysis**

SB 186 restores the right to a person who has been convicted of a non-violent felony to carry a firearm 5 years after completion of the sentence for the last felony offense if no additional charges are pending against the person. The measure strikes language prohibiting any felon from riding in a vehicle with a firearm in the vehicle. Additionally, the measure strikes obsolete language relating to handgun licenses.
