**Bill Analysis**

The FS for SB 229 allows the State Board of Education to renew an individual's emergency/provisional teaching certificate for up to 5 years if he or she maintains a district evaluation rating of "effective" or higher under the Teacher and Leader Effectiveness Evaluation System and meets other requirements, including having been granted an emergency/provisional certificate for 2 years, submitting a portfolio of his or her work to the State Board of Education, and having an employment contract renewed. The FS clarifies that teachers with an emergency or provisional certificate may be hired on a temporary contract by a school district for more than 4 semesters or on multiple temporary contracts.
