**Bill Analysis**

SB 229 allows the State Board of Education to renew an individual's emergency/provisional teaching certificate for up to 5 years if he or she maintains a district evaluation rating of "effective" or higher under the Teacher and Leader Effectiveness Evaluation System and meets other requirements, including having been granted an emergency/provisional certificate for 2 years, submitting a portfolio of his or her work to the State Board of Education, and having an employment contract renewed.
