**Bill Analysis**

SB 238 creates a 9-member task force until December 31, 2021, to study the possibility of requiring each high school student to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) prior to graduation. The task force membership includes a member of the House of Representatives, a member of the Senate, representatives from school districts and representatives from higher education. The measure requires the task force to hold an organizational meeting by September 1, 2021, and prohibits task force members from receiving compensation or travel reimbursements. The measure subjects the task force to the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act. The task force must submit a report of its findings and recommendations by December 31, 2021.
