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Bill Analysis

SB 252 requires all public and charter high schools to offer a minimum of 1 computer science course beginning in the 2024-25 school year. The measure requires all public and charter middle schools to offer instruction in exploratory computer science content beginning in the 2024-25 school year and requires all public and charter elementary schools to offer instruction in the basics of computer science content and computational thinking beginning in the 2024-25 school year. Additionally, the measure requires school districts and charter schools by June 30, 2025, and each June 30 thereafter, to submit a report to the State Department of Education regarding computer science courses or content offered during the previous school year. The measure also requires the Department to post the reports online.

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
