**Bill Analysis**

SB 332 establishes and gradually raises a state minimum wage. The minimum wage is raised in the following manner:

- 1) January 1, 2022, the state's minimum wage shall be \$8.50
- 2) January 1, 2023, the state's minimum wage shall be \$9.75
- 3) January 1, 2024, the state's minimum wage shall be \$11.00
- 4) January 1, 2023, the state's minimum wage shall be \$13.00
- 5) January 1, 2023, the state's minimum wage shall be \$15.00
- 6) January 1, 2023 and every year thereafter, the state's minimum wage shall increase according to the Consumer Price Index (CPI) percentage increase from the prior year.
