Bill Analysis

SB 386 creates the Digital Wallet Program Act to be administered by the Governor or his or her designee to provide funds directly to parents for educational supplies, tutoring, technology needs or other educational expenses. The measure directs grants to be distributed first to parents whose household income is equal to or less than 185% of the federal poverty level, then to parents whose household income is equal to or less than 300% of the federal poverty level, then to parents whose household income is equal to or less than 350% of the federal poverty level, and then to parents of all income levels. Additionally, the measure directs the Governor or his or her designee to submit an annual report on the program by Dec. 31 to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
