**Bill Analysis**

SB 486 states that any federal, state, or municipal order, court order, policy, rule or regulation ordering the buy back, confiscation or surrender of firearms or firearm accessories from law-abiding citizens to be an infringement on the rights of citizens to keep and bear arms. The measure prohibits any law enforcement officer from obeying or enforcing any such order or law and also prohibits any agency from terminating said officer's employment for complying with the provisions of this measure.
