**Bill Analysis**

SB 565 creates the State Capitol Preservation Office and consolidates the various responsibilities for preserving and maintaining the Capitol building under the newly created Office. The Office shall be placed under the State Capitol Preservation Commission's authority. Additionally, the measure requires the State Capitol Preservation Commission to provide enhancement of the Capitol's design, maintain the grounds, modify the building as needed, and preserve and restore the historical features of the Capitol. The measure modifies the membership of the Commission to include the Pro Tempore and Speaker as well as former members of the Senate and House. The Executive Director of the newly created Office is also placed on the Commission. The Commission is directed to meet at least once on a quarterly basis.
