**Bill Analysis**

The FS for SB 767 provides for school districts to authorize persons who possess a handgun license and demonstrate a proficiency in handgun training and campus-specific active shooter training to carry firearms on school property. The FS requires such employees to have completed at least 4 hours of weapon retention training certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET) as well as 4 hours of campus-specific active shooter training as determined by the appropriate law enforcement agency. A local law enforcement agency may require additional training as deemed necessary by the agency.
