Bill Analysis

SB 803 prohibits public school districts and charter schools from teaching, instructing or training any student to believe certain divisive concepts as defined in the measure. The measure allows a teacher to be dismissed or not reemployed for teaching, instructing or training such concepts, subject to the provisions of the Teacher Due Process Act of 1990. It clarifies that the bill does not prohibit discussing, as part of a larger course of academic instruction, the divisive concepts in an objective manner without endorsement.
