**Bill Analysis**

SB 814 increases the penalty for repeated convictions of possession or selling Schedule I or II substances. Any person convicted of a 2<sup>nd</sup> or subsequent offense shall be guilty of a felony punishable by a maximum term of imprisonment of 3 years and a fine of up to \$5,000.00. Any person convicted of a 5<sup>th</sup> or subsequent offense shall be guilty of a felony punishable by a maximum term of imprisonment of 7 years and a fine of up to \$10,000.00. These increased penalties shall not apply to persons convicted of possession as it relates to marijuana and certain other substances.
