**Bill Analysis**

SB 907 requires all operating railroads transporting freight to submit to the Department of Transportation a report containing the total miles of railroad track and the number of railroad and public highway, road or street intersections on its track during the previous calendar year on the 1<sup>st</sup> of March each year. The measure provides for an assessment of \$0.075 to be made on each mile of track and for \$100.00 on each railroad intersection where 1 or more railroad tracks intersect with a public highway or street. Revenue from these assessments shall be deposited in the Municipal Railway Bridge Construction Revolving Fund, which may be used by the Department to construct bridges at railroad crossings within municipalities.
