**Bill Analysis**

SJR 21 submits to the people a constitutional amendment that clarifies the meaning of arms as it relates to keeping and bearing arms and specifies that the Legislature may narrowly adopt tailored to time, place, and manner regulations, or authorize political subdivisions to adopt and enforce such regulations, to serve a compelling state interest. The measure prohibits any law from establishing a gun registry or specifically taxing the keeping of arms.
