An Act relating to broadband; making appropriations to the Oklahoma Broadband Governing Board; describing
and limiting the use of said funds; identifying source and amounts of appropriated funds; referencing
actions of the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding; and providing for noncodification.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
From the Statewide Recovery Fund created pursuant to Enrolled
House Bill 3349 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature,
the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) shall be appropriated
to the Oklahoma Broadband Governing Board created pursuant to
Enrolled House Bill 3363 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma

Legislature. Such funds shall be used for Broadband Mapping needs as
recommended and approved by the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief
Funding on December 6, 2021. Such funds shall be used to complete
the Broadband Map needed to create the Statewide Broadband Plan.
SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

7 From the Statewide Recovery Fund created pursuant to Enrolled 8 House Bill 3349 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, 9 the sum of Three Hundred Sixty-five Thousand Sixty-eight Dollars 10 (\$365,068.00) shall be appropriated to the Oklahoma Broadband 11 Governing Board created pursuant to Enrolled House Bill 3363 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature. Such funds shall be 12 13 used for the Oklahoma State University Institute of Technology's 14 Advanced Fiber Technician Training Program as recommended and 15 approved by the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding on March 16 31, 2022.
