A. As a way to honor and recognize the veterans 17 who have served our country, the Department of Public Safety shall 18 make space available in the upper left-hand corner of the front of 19 the driver license and the identification card for a flag emblem and 20 the word "veteran". When applicable, the Department of Public 21 Safety shall, on the front or back of the driver license or the 22 identification card, include a numeric designation indicating a 23

veteran's one hundred percent (100%) disability rating granted to

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1 the veteran by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs. The items required by this subsection shall to be designed by the 2 Department of Public Safety that will and shall serve as a notation 3 of veteran status and as a notation of the existence of a United 4 5 States Department of Veterans Affairs disability rating as applicable. The current spouse of a one-hundred-percent disabled 6 veteran or a surviving spouse of a deceased, one-hundred-percent 7 disabled veteran, who has not remarried, shall be entitled to 8 9 receive a driver license or identification card indicating his or 10 her status as an eligible current spouse or an eligible surviving 11 spouse who has not remarried entitled to the sales tax exemption 12 provided in Section 1357 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Representation of veteran status and disability rating on the driver 13 license and the identification card shall be adequate confirmation 14 for purposes of veterans benefits offered by public or private 15

B. Upon application for issuance or renewal of the driver license or identification card and in addition to other documentation required by the Department, persons requesting the flag emblem or the flag emblem and disability notation shall be registered with the veterans registry Oklahoma Veterans Registry created by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Provided,

documentation shall be required except as specifically mandated by

entities doing business within this state and no further

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federal law.

- that if the person requesting the flag emblem has previously
 received a flag emblem pursuant to this subsection, no registration
 with the veterans registry shall be required to receive the flag
 emblem prior to the deadline established in subsection C of this
 section.
- C. The Department of Public Safety and the Oklahoma Department 6 of Veterans Affairs shall implement a technology-based information 7 exchange process where the Department of Public Safety and all motor 8 9 license agents are able to validate, upon application for issuance 10 or renewal of the driver license or identification card, an 11 applicant's claim of veteran status, veteran disability status, 12 status as a current spouse of an eligible disabled veteran, or status as an eligible surviving spouse of an eligible deceased 13 disabled veteran as provided for in subsection A of this section. 14 The requirements of this subsection shall be implemented no later 15 than July 1, 2023. 16
 - <u>D.</u> The Department of Public Safety shall promulgate any rule necessary to implement the provisions of this section.
 - SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
