Fiscal Analysis

HB 1679 the "Sarah Stitt Act", directs DOC to coordinate with DPS to provide non-renewable, Real ID noncompliant identification cards to inmates upon release. This bill may require additional staffing hours, however neither DPS nor DOC anticipate a significant impact to their budgets. It has been determined that producing these non-renewable, REAL ID noncompliant ID cards will have no additional cost to the state.
