PROPOSAL: New

The measure expresses the legislative intent to begin the exploration of alternative revenue sources that may be implemented in lieu of the gas tax structure now in place by creating the Road User Charge Task Force and establishing membership and meeting requirements. The bill establishes duties of the task force and it requires the task force to submit a report to the Legislature by December 31, 2023 on how best to implement the Road User Charge Program. It requires the Oklahoma Tax Commission to administer the collection of any charges or fees associated with the Oklahoma Road User Charge Program. It requires collections from the road usage charges be specifically designated for the purpose of maintaining and improving the roads, highways and bridges in the State of Oklahoma.
