**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1799 modifies the process for expunging a juvenile court records. Per the AOC, petitions for these types of expungements are rare as Juvenile Court Clerks typically receive motions and orders for expungements at the conclusion of cases. The agency does not expect this bill to have a fiscal impact on the courts.
