**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1903 provides that inmates who are "medically frail" and "medically vulnerable," as certified by the medical director of DOC, to be eligible for medical parole consideration. The fiscal impact of HB 1903 is contingent on several factors including, but not limited to, age, type of medical condition(s), comorbidities, medication needs, etc. As such, a more precise estimate is indeterminable at this time.
