Fiscal Analysis

HB 3647 creates the Oklahoma Golf Trail Commission which will consist of 9 members and its main purpose will be to annually select at least 15 but not more than 25 golf courses as the official Oklahoma Golf Trail. The act gives the commission additional powers and responsibilities which are similar to other state agencies in order to fulfill its purpose and to stimulate economic development and enhance tourism through rounds of golf played in OK. This commission is being authorized to eventually operate as an agency, the act allows the Commission to accept private donations to fund operations until permanent appropriations can be allocated. Also, the CS provides for the members of the Commission to be reimbursed in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act. Those costs are usually minimal.
