Engrossed SB 343 proposes to amend 68 O.S. §205.2, which allows a qualified entity seeking to collect unpaid, court-ordered monetary obligations for a debt, unpaid fines, and costs, or final judgment of at least \$50 from an individual who has filed a state income tax return, to file a claim with the Oklahoma Tax Commission requesting that the amount owed be deducted from the individual's state income tax refund. The proposal clarifies that a claim may be filed for unpaid municipal and district court fines and removes obsolete language.
