Fiscal Analysis

SB 814 increases the penalty for repeated convictions of possession or selling Schedule I or II substances. This bill could result in an increase in Oklahoma's incarcerated population, however the fiscal impact is contingent in the number of people convicted of the offenses listed in the bill. Average daily cost per inmate for maximum, medium, and minimum security is \$108.17, \$61.71, and \$57.39 respectively.
