6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to transportation; stating
8 legislative intent; requiring the Oklahoma Department
9 of Transportation sign and send application
10 requesting Historic U.S. Route 66 be declared a U.S.
11 Bicycle Route by certain date; requiring signage be
12 placed on certain highway; providing for
13 noncodification; providing for codification; and
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 Currently, there are no U.S. Bicycle Routes in the state of
19 Oklahoma. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature to cause the
20 Oklahoma Department of Transportation to submit application to the
21 American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials
22 (AASHTO) requesting that the section of Historic U.S. Route 66 that
23 travels through this state be designated as a U.S. Bicycle Route.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4019.1 of Title 69, unless there
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 On or before November 1, 2021, the Oklahoma Department of
5 Transportation shall sign and then send a completed application to
6 the American Association of State Highway and Transportation
7 Officials (AASHTO) to request that the organization designate the
8 section of Historic U.S. Route 66 that travels through this state as
9 a U.S. Bicycle Route. If the application is accepted and Historic
10 U.S. Route 66 is designated as a U.S. Bicycle Route, the Department
11 shall cause suitable permanent markers marking the route to be
12 placed on the highway.

13 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
