Supp. 2020, Ch. 62, App.), is amended to 15 read as follows: 16 Rule 2.43 Contributions to a candidate committee may be used to 17 make expenditures for ordinary and necessary campaign expenses, for 18 contributions to another candidate committee, for operating expenses 19 of the committee or for other purposes not otherwise prohibited by 20 law or these Rules. "Ordinary and necessary campaign expenses" as 21 used in this section are those that would not exist but for the 22 candidate's campaign, including but not limited to staff salaries, 23 campaign consulting fees, rent (other than for the candidate's 24 residence or part of a residence), travel, advertising, telephones,
