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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; prohibiting  
8 state governmental entities organized within the  
executive branch of state government from requiring  
9 certain evidence related to surgical procedures;  
providing for codification; providing an effective  
10 date; and declaring an emergency.

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9501 of Title 74, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 No agency, board, commission, department, instrumentality or  
18 other entity organized within the executive branch of state  
19 government shall require, if applicable, on any form or other  
20 document used by the state governmental entity as part of a process  
21 for changing gender identification on a driver license or any permit  
22 or other form of identification used by such entity an affidavit,  
23 attesting to the applicant's gender identity. The applicant's  
24 affidavit shall be accepted as conclusive proof of gender change if

1 it contains substantially the following language: "I, [name of  
2 applicant], hereby attest under penalty of perjury that the request  
3 for a change in gender to (female, male or nonbinary) is to conform  
4 my legal gender to my gender identity and is not for any fraudulent  
5 purpose."

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
8 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
