7	An Act relating to tourism and recreation; enacting the Oklahoma Golf Trail Creation Act; creating
8	Oklahoma Golf Trail Commission; creating Oklahoma Golf Trail; providing for membership of Commission;
9	prescribing method of appointment; prescribing terms; imposing requirements for membership on Commission;
10	authorizing removal for cause; providing for filling of vacancies; providing for quorum; providing for
11	effect of lack of quorum; providing for appointment of officers; providing for adoption of administrative
12	rules; prescribing authorized meetings; requiring meetings to comply with Oklahoma Open Meeting Act;

22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2400 of Title 74, unless there
 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Golf 5 Trail Creation Act".

6 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2401 of Title 74, unless there 8 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 There is hereby created the Oklahoma Golf Trail Commission, 10 hereinafter referred to as the "Commission", and the Oklahoma Golf 11 Trail, hereinafter referred to as the "Golf Trail".

12 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2402 of Title 74, unless there 14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Commission shall consist of nine (9) members, each ofwhom shall serve a term of six (6) years.

B. Five members shall be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor,
two members shall be appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House
of Representatives, and two members shall be appointed by the
President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate.

21 Members selected to the Commission must be knowledgeable about 22 the Oklahoma golf industry including:

23 1. Golf course marketing;

24 2. Golf course ownership;

3. Golf course management; or

4. Tourism and commerce in Oklahoma.

C. Commission members may be removed for cause. Whenever a vacancy on the Commission occurs by death, resignation, or otherwise, the appointing authority shall fill the same by appointment, and the appointee shall hold office during the unexpired term. Each member shall hold office until a successor has been appointed.

9 D. Five members of the Commission shall constitute a quorum,
10 and the vote of the majority of members present shall be necessary
11 for any action to be taken by the Commission.

E. No vacancy in the membership of the Commission shall impair the rights of a quorum to exercise and perform all the rights and duties of the Commission.

F. The Commission shall appoint from the Commission the chair,vice-chair, and secretary.

G. The Commission is authorized and directed to adopt rules
pursuant to the provisions of the Administrative Procedures Act to
execute the powers and duties of the Commission.

H. The Commission may meet monthly and shall meet at least quarterly. The Commission may meet at such other times as it deems necessary for effectively performing its duties and responsibilities. Special meetings may be called by the chair or by

any three members of the Commission. The meetings of the Commission
 shall be subject to the Open Meeting Act.

I. The Commission is hereby declared to be a governmental agency and instrumentality of the State of Oklahoma with authority to exercise the rights, privileges, and functions hereinafter specified in addition to those it now has.

J. The Commission shall evaluate and approve a list of not less than fifteen but not more than twenty-five golf courses annually to be listed as the official Oklahoma Golf Trail for tourism and marketing purposes. The list shall be reviewed every year for renewal of approval.

12 K. Members of the Commission shall not be personally liable for13 damages from actions in furtherance of the Commission.

14 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2403 of Title 74, unless there 16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There are hereby granted to and imposed on the Commission, and in any commission or body which may hereafter succeed to the powers, rights, and duties of the Commission, the additional powers, rights, and duties hereinafter more specifically provided.

B. The mission of the Commission is to increase rounds of golf played at the Oklahoma Golf Trail Member Courses to stimulate economic development, enhance tourism, attract new residents and

1 retirees to the state, and to elevate the quality of life and 2 experience in Oklahoma. 3 С. The Commission is hereby authorized to: 1. Sue and be sued; 4 5 2. Adopt, use, and alter an official seal; 6 Make bylaws for the management and regulation of its 3. 7 affairs; 4. Appoint, prescribe the duties, and fix the compensation for 8 9 officers, agents, and employees; 10 5. Make contracts and execute instruments as in the judgment of 11 the Commission are necessary or convenient to the exercise of the 12 powers conferred upon it by law; 13 6. Sell advertising; provided, that such advertising shall be 14 approved by the Commission prior to acceptance for publication; and 15 7. Promulgate rules and policies necessary and convenient to 16 the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by law. 17 D. The Commission shall be responsible for the following: 18 Evaluating and selecting marketing options for the Oklahoma 1. 19 Golf Trail; 20 Set membership fees for Trail courses; 2. 21 3. Evaluate courses based on condition, location, course fees, 22 and any other variable relevant for Trail course selection; and 23 24

4. Develop interagency, intra-agency and public-private
 collaborations to help advance the awareness and mission of the
 Oklahoma Golf Trail.

4 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2404 of Title 74, unless there 6 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The Commission shall be able to accept private donations to fund8 operations until permanent appropriations can be allocated.

9 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
