All statutes of this state requiring, authorizing, 19 imposing or relating to the death penalty are in full force and 20 effect, subject to legislative amendment or repeal by statute, 21 initiative or referendum. Any method of execution shall be allowed, 22 unless prohibited by the United States Constitution. Methods of 23 execution may be designated by the Legislature hereby repealed. A
