14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
15	2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
16	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18	the following proposed amendment to Section 3 of Article V of the
19	Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:
20	Section 3. Referendum petitions shall be filed with the
21	Secretary of State not more than ninety (90) days after the final
22	adjournment of the session of the Legislature which passed the bill
23	on which the referendum is demanded. The veto power of the Governor
24	shall not extend to measures voted on by the people. All elections

1	on measures referred to the people of the state shall be had at the
2	next election held throughout the state, except when the Legislature
3	or the Governor shall order a special election for the express
4	purpose of making such reference. Any Except as otherwise provided,
5	any measure referred to the people by the an initiative shall take
6	effect and be in force when it shall have been approved by a fifty-
7	five-percent majority of the votes cast thereon and not otherwise.
8	An initiative that only repeals a provision or provisions of the
9	Constitution or referendum shall take effect and be in force when it
10	shall have been approved by a majority of the votes cast thereon and
11	not otherwise.
12	The style of all bills shall be: "Be it Enacted By the People
13	of the State of Oklahoma."
14	Petitions and orders for the initiative and for the referendum
15	shall be filed with the Secretary of State and addressed to the
16	Governor of the state, who shall submit the same to the people. The
17	Legislature shall make suitable provisions for carrying into effect
18	the provisions of this article.
19	SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
20	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
21	the following form:

THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

1 This measure amends Section 3 of Article 5 of the Oklahoma 2 Constitution. It requires a fifty-five percent (55%) majority 3 vote of the people to pass an initiative petition to amend the 4 Constitution. It requires a majority vote to repeal provisions 5 of the Constitution. 6 SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED? 7 FOR THE PROPOSAL - YES 8 AGAINST THE PROPOSAL - NO 9 SECTION 3.
