6	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1421, as							
7	renumbered by Section 3, Chapter 18, O.S.L. 2014 (2 O.S. Supp. 2020,							
8	Section 11-90), is amended to read as follows:							
9	Section 11-90. This act shall be known and may be cited as the							
10	"Sergeant Craig Johnson Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act".							
11	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1422, as							
12	amended by Section 2, Chapter 230, O.S.L. 2013, and as renumbered by							
13	Section 4, Chapter 18, O.S.L. 2014 (2 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 11-							
14	91), is amended to read as follows:							
15	Section 11-91. As used in the <u>Sergeant Craig Johnson</u> Oklahoma							
16	Scrap Metal Dealers Act:							
17	1. "Aluminum material" means the metal aluminum or aluminum							
18	alloy or anything made of either aluminum or aluminum alloy, except							
19	aluminum beverage cans;							
20	2. "Copper material" means the metal copper or copper alloy or							
21	anything made of either copper or copper alloy;							
22	3. "Department" means the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture,							
23	Food, and Forestry and its employees, officers and divisions;							
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4. <u>"Digital image" means pixels intended for display on a</u> computer monitor or for transformation into another format, such as a printed page. For purposes of this paragraph, "pixels" shall mean raster-based, two-dimensional, rectangular arrays of static data elements;

An exempted seller 13 includes, but is not limited to: 14 a mechanical, electrical or plumbing contractor a. 15 currently licensed to do business in this any state, 16 b. a scrap metal dealer (Standard Industrial 17 Classification Codes 5051 or 5093), currently licensed 18 pursuant to the provisions of the Sergeant Craig 19 Johnson Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act, 20 с. holder of a current farm-use tax permit, 21 d. manufacturer, 22 distributor, or e. 23 f. retailer with a current sales tax permit, or 24

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1	g. any state-recognized business entity including a
2	corporation, limited liability company, partnership,
3	limited partnership and sole proprietorship;
4	5. <u>6.</u> "License" means a scrap metal dealer license;
5	6. 7. "Remote storage battery" means a battery commonly used in
6	telecommunications, the oil industry or infrastructure;
7	8. "Scrap metal" means any copper material or aluminum material
8	or any item listed in Section $\frac{1424}{11-93}$ of this title, offered for
9	sale or resale or purchased by any person, firm or <del>corporation</del>
10	business;
11	7. 9. "Scrap metal dealer" means any person, firm or
12	corporation business being an owner, keeper or proprietor of a
13	retail or wholesale business which buys, sells, salvages, processes
14	or otherwise handles scrap metal materials regulated by the
15	provisions of the <u>Sergeant Craig Johnson</u> Oklahoma Scrap Metal
16	Dealers Act; and
17	$\frac{8.10}{10.1}$ "Yard" means the place where any scrap metal dealer
18	stores scrap metal materials or keeps such materials for purpose of
19	sale.
20	SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1423, as
21	renumbered by Section 5, Chapter 18, O.S.L. 2014, and as last
22	amended by Section 1, Chapter 23, O.S.L. 2018 (2 O.S. Supp. 2020,
23	Section 11-92), is amended to read as follows:
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Section 11-92. A. Every scrap metal dealer shall keep a separate book, record or other electronic system as authorized by the <u>Sergeant Craig Johnson</u> Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act, to record and maintain the following data from any seller of any amount of scrap metal as defined by the <u>Sergeant Craig Johnson</u> Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act:

A legible photocopy of the seller's driver license or
government provided photo identification, issued by the United
States government, State of Oklahoma, or any other state of the
United States, or any other federally recognized identification that
contains his or her name, address, and date of birth, weight and
height; however, if the photo identification does not contain an
address, an address must be provided;

14 2. Vehicle description and license tag number of the seller, or 15 vehicle identification number if no state license plate is affixed, 16 if the vehicle was used to transport the material being sold;

17 3. Date and place of the transaction and the transaction number
18 as provided by the scrap metal dealer;

<sup>19</sup> 4. Description of the items sold and weight of the items as <sup>20</sup> required by the provisions of the <u>Sergeant Craig Johnson</u> Oklahoma <sup>21</sup> Scrap Metal Dealers Act;

5. Whether the scrap metal is in wire, cable, bar, rod, sheet or tube form; and

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- 1 6. If any insulation is on the scrap metal, the names and 2 addresses of the persons, groups or corporations from whom seller 3 purchased or obtained the materials; and 4 7. If apparent on the scrap metal, the name of the manufacturer 5 and serial number of each item of scrap metal Digital images of the 6 items purchased and a digital image of the seller. The digital 7 images shall be captured in the common JPEG format and contain 8 depictions that clearly identify the items sold and the seller. The 9 digital images shall be retained by the purchaser for a minimum of 10 ninety (90) days from the date of purchase. 11 Municipalities or other political subdivisions may designate в. 12 the reporting methods and the format of the information required by 13 subsection A of this section, either written, electronic or 14 Internet-based. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 15 Forestry shall designate an Internet-based reporting method that 16 applies to all geographic areas of the state that are not subject to 17 a local designation for Internet reporting. 18 C. Records required by this section shall be retained for no 19 less than two (2) years from the date of transaction and shall be 20 made available at any time to any person authorized by law for such 21 inspection. 22 D. Purchases of thirty-five (35) pounds or more of scrap metal 23 containing a manufacturer's serial number or other unique label or
- <sup>24</sup> mark shall be held separate and apart so that the purchased scrap

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1	metal may be readily identifiable from all other purchases for a
2	period of not less than ten (10) days from the date of purchase.
3	During the holding period the scrap metal dealer may not change the
4	form of the purchased scrap metal and shall permit any person
5	authorized by law to make inspection of such materials.
6	E. Purchases of thirty-five (35) pounds or more of scrap metal
7	which does not contain a manufacturer's serial number or other
8	unique label or mark shall either be held for the same time and in
9	the same manner as required by subsection D of this section; or in
10	the alternative, the scrap metal dealer shall be required to obtain
11	a digital image of the items purchased, the seller of the items, a
12	copy of the bill of sale and a copy of the seller's photo
13	identification. The digital image shall contain a depiction that
14	clearly identifies the seller and the items sold and is captured in
15	the common JPEG format. The digital image shall be retained by the
16	purchaser for a minimum of ninety (90) days from the date of
17	purchase. For the purpose of this section a "digital image" means a
18	raster-based two-dimensional, rectangular array of static data
19	elements called pixels, intended for display on a computer monitor
20	or for transformation into another format, such as a printed page.
21	F. No purchase of any amount of scrap metal from an exempted
22	seller, as defined by Section 11-91 of this title, shall be subject
23	to any holding period or digital imaging identification required by
24	subsection D or E of this section.
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1	G. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell or purchase							
2	copper material or copper wire from which the actual or apparent							
3	insulation or other coating has been burned, melted or exposed to							
4	heat or fire resulting in melting some or all of the insulation or							
5	coating. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell or purchase							
6	copper wire that is four-gauge or larger in size. This subsection							
7	shall not apply to sales by or purchases from an exempted seller as							
8	defined by Section 11-91 of this title. Documentation of exempt							
9	seller status shall be provided to the scrap metal dealer and, if							
10	requested by a law enforcement agency where the purchase was made,							
11	shall be transmitted to the law enforcement agency and may be kept							
12	as permanent record and made available for public inspection.							
13	<del>H.</del> It shall be unlawful for any scrap metal dealer to purchase							
14	any item from a minor person under the age of sixteen (16) without							
15	having first obtained the consent, in writing, of a parent or							
16	guardian of such minor. Such written consent shall be kept with the							
17	book, record or other electronic recording system required by							
18	subsection A of this section and, if requested by a law enforcement							
19	agency where the purchase was made, shall be transmitted to the law							
20	enforcement agency and may be kept as a permanent record and made							
21	available for public inspection.							
22	<del>I.</del> E. A scrap metal dealer shall obtain from each seller of a							

<sup>22</sup> I. E. A scrap metal dealer shall obtain from each seller of a <sup>23</sup> scrap metal item regulated by the <u>Sergeant Craig Johnson</u> Oklahoma <sup>24</sup> Scrap Metal Dealers Act, or a parent or guardian on behalf of a

<sup>1</sup> minor, a written declaration of ownership containing a legible <sup>2</sup> signature of the seller. The declaration of ownership shall be in <sup>3</sup> the following form and shall appear on the bill of sale or <sup>4</sup> transaction ticket to be completed by the seller in the presence of <sup>5</sup> the purchaser at the time of the transaction:

<sup>6</sup> "I hereby affirm under penalty of prosecution that I am the <sup>7</sup> rightful owner of the hereon described merchandise; or I am an <sup>8</sup> authorized representative of the rightful owner and affirm that I <sup>9</sup> have been given authority by the rightful owner to sell the hereon <sup>10</sup> described merchandise.

If requested by a law enforcement agency, a scrap metal 16 dealer shall report in writing all purchases of scrap metal as 17 defined by the Sergeant Craig Johnson Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers 18 Act within forty-eight (48) hours following such purchase. The 19 report shall contain all the information required by this section. 20 K. A scrap metal dealer purchasing a vehicle from any person 21 shall be required to record the information required in subsection A 22 of this section and the make, model, license tag number and vehicle

- <sup>23</sup> identification number of the purchased vehicle. A person selling a
- <sup>24</sup> vehicle to a scrap metal dealer shall be required to present to the

1	dealer the title of the vehicle or a certificate of ownership form,							
2	as approved by the Oklahoma Tax Commission and available at the							
3	Oklahoma Tax Commission or through a motor license agent, in							
4	addition to signing a declaration of ownership as required by							
5	subsection I of this section. The scrap metal dealer shall not							
6	provide payment for the vehicle until the certificate of ownership							
7	has been submitted to the Oklahoma Tax Commission or a motor license							
8	agent, and the vehicle is determined not to be stolen. The							
9	provisions of this subsection shall not apply to sales, purchases or							
10	other transfer of vehicles between scrap metal dealers and licensed							
11	automotive dismantlers and parts recyclers.							
12	L. The provisions of the Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act shall							
13	not apply to the sale or purchase of aluminum beverage cans for							
14	recycling purposes.							
15	M. G. Prior to the purchase of a used motor vehicle, trailer or							
16	nonmotorized recreational vehicle, the scrap metal dealer shall							
17	require one of the following forms of proof of ownership from the							
18	person selling the used motor vehicle, trailer or nonmotorized							
19	recreational vehicle:							
20	1. A certificate of title that matches the vehicle							
21	identification number of the vehicle being sold;							
22	2. A notarized power of attorney from the individual on the							
23	certificate of title authorizing the seller to dispose of the							
24 27	vehicle on behalf of the owner; or							

1	3. A statement of ownership from the seller stating that the							
2	vehicle was purchased from the lawful owner, accompanied by a bill							
3	of sale from the lawful owner including a statement that there are							
4	no outstanding liens on the vehicle, and a statement that the							
5	vehicle is inoperable or incapable of operation or use on the							
6	highway and has no resale value except as scrap.							
7	The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to sales,							
8	purchases or other transfers of vehicles between scrap metal dealers							
9	and licensed automotive dismantlers and parts recyclers, licensed							
10	crushers, salvage dealers, used car dealers and licensed wreckers.							
11	<u>H.</u> A scrap metal dealer shall not enter into any cash							
12	transactions in excess of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) in							
13	payment for the purchase of scrap metal that is listed in subsection							
14	$\frac{1}{2}$ C of Section 11-93 of this title unless the transaction is made							
15	with an exempted seller. Payment by check shall be issued and made							
16	payable only to the seller of the scrap metal whose identification							
17	information has been obtained pursuant to the provisions of this							
18	section.							
19	I. The following are exempt from the provisions of the Sergeant							
20	Craig Johnson Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act:							
21	1. Scrap metal transported by a scrap metal dealer for an							
22	exempted seller using a commercial motor vehicle; and							
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1	2. Scrap metal delivered by an exempt seller to a scrap metal							
2	dealer that is paid for by the scrap metal dealer with a check made							
3	payable to the exempt seller's company or entity.							
4	SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1424, as							
5	renumbered by Section 6, Chapter 18, O.S.L. 2014 (2 O.S. Supp. 2020,							
6	Section 11-93), is amended to read as follows:							
7	Section 11-93. A. <del>Scrap</del> <u>It shall be unlawful for scrap</u> metal							
8	dealers permitted to do business in this state as required by the							
9	<u>Sergeant Craig Johnson</u> Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act <del>shall not</del> <u>to</u>							
10	purchase any item listed in subsection $\frac{1}{2}$ Of this section without:							
11	1. Obtaining proof that the seller owns or is authorized to							
12	sell the property, by evidence of a receipt of purchase <del>or</del> , a bill							
13	of sale for the property or a contract or other documentation; and							
14	2. Requiring the seller to sign a written declaration in the							
15	form required by subsection $\pm E$ of Section $3$ of this act 11-92 of							
16	this title; or							
17	3. Obtaining proof that the seller is an exempted seller or an							
18	employee of an exempted seller, as defined in Section <del>2 of this act</del>

20	B. Scrap metal dealers shall not purchase any regulated items							
21	which are not delivered in or on a motor vehicle.							
22	<u>C.</u> The following items are regulated by the provisions of <del>this</del>							
23	act the Sergeant Craig Johnson Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act:							
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1 1. Manhole covers, street signs, traffic signs, traffic 2 signals, including their fixtures and hardware, and highway guard 3 rails, or any other identifiable public property; 4 2. Electric light poles, including their fixtures and hardware, 5 electric transmission or distribution cable and wires, and any other 6 hardware associated with electric utility or telecommunication 7 systems; 8 3. Highway guard rails Any copper wire, braided or single 9 strand, insulated or not insulated, that is four gauge or larger in 10 size; 11 4. Copper wire from which the actual or apparent insulation or 12 other coating has been burned, melted or exposed to heat or fire 13 resulting in melting some or all other insulation or coating; 14 5. Funeral markers, plaques or funeral vases; 15 5. 6. Historical markers or public artifacts; 16 6. 7. Railroad equipment; 17 7. 8. Any metal item marked with any form of the name, initials 18 or logo of a governmental entity, utility, cemetery or railroad; 19 8. 9. Condensing or evaporating coil from a heating or air 20 conditioning unit including copper coil ends; 21 9. 10. Aluminum or stainless steel containers or bottles 22 designed to contain fuel; 23 10. 11. Metal beer kegs that are clearly marked as being the 24 property of the beer manufacturer; \_ \_

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1 11. 12. Metal bleachers or other seating facilities used in 2 recreational areas or sporting arenas; 3 12. 13. Automotive catalytic converters; 4 13. Plumbing or electrical fixtures; 5 14. <del>Tools;</del> 6 15. Machinery or supplies commonly used in the drilling, 7 completing, operating or repairing of oil or gas wells; and 8 16. 15. Stainless steel fittings and fixtures commonly used in 9 the operation of car wash facilities; and 10 16. Remote storage batteries. 11 SECTION 5. 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1425, as AMENDATORY 12 amended by Section 4, Chapter 230, O.S.L. 2013, and as renumbered by 13 Section 7, Chapter 18, O.S.L. 2014 (2 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 11-14 94), is amended to read as follows: 15 Section 11-94. A. Any person found in violation of any 16 provision of the Sergeant Craig Johnson Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers 17 Act, with the exceptions as provided by subsections B, C and D of 18 this section, shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and 19 punished by a fine of not more than Two Thousand Five Hundred 20 Dollars (\$2,500.00) per offense. Any person convicted of a second 21 violation of the Sergeant Craig Johnson Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers 22 Act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not 23 more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) per offense or by 24 imprisonment in the county jail for a period of not more than six \_ \_

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(6) months. Any person convicted of a third or subsequent violation of the <u>Sergeant Craig Johnson</u> Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act shall be guilty of a felony punishable by a fine of not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) per offense or by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a period of not more than two (2) years, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

B. Any person acting as a scrap metal dealer without a scrap metal dealer license or a sales tax permit as required by the <u>Sergeant Craig Johnson</u> Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00); provided, that each day of operation in violation of the <u>Sergeant Craig Johnson</u> Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act shall constitute a separate offense.

C. Any person who knowingly provides false information with respect to the provisions of subsection I of Section <u>1423</u> <u>11-92</u> of this title shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony and punished by a fine of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a period of not more than two (2) years, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

D. Any person convicted of purchasing or selling burnt copper material or copper wire as prohibited by subsection G of Section 1423 <u>11-93</u> of this title shall, upon first conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred

Dollars (\$2,500.00). Any person convicted of a second or subsequent violation shall be guilty of a felony punishable by a fine of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a period of not more than two (2) years, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

E. Each scrap metal dealer convicted of a violation of the <u>Sergeant Craig Johnson</u> Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act shall be reported to the Oklahoma Tax Commission by the clerk of the court rendering such verdict.

F. The Tax Commission shall revoke the sales tax permit of any person convicted of three separate violations of the <u>Sergeant Craig</u> <u>Johnson</u> Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act. The person shall not be eligible to receive a sales tax permit for such purpose for a period of one (1) year following the revocation. The revocation procedure shall be subject to notice and hearing as required by Section <del>1426</del> 11-95 of this title.

SECTION 6. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1426, as renumbered by Section 8, Chapter 18, O.S.L. 2014 (2 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 11-95), is amended to read as follows:

Section 11-95. A. Any sales tax permit, issued pursuant to
Section 1364 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to any scrap
metal dealer who violates any of the provisions of this act relating
to the purchase of copper or aluminum materials or any scrap metal
regulated by this act, may be canceled or suspended for a period not

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1 to exceed thirty (30) days by the Oklahoma Tax Commission. The Tax 2 Commission may refuse the issuance of or extension or reinstatement 3 of any permit where the applicant or holder of the permit shall have 4 violated any provisions of this act or existing laws. Such 5 cancellation or refusal shall be mandatory as to any scrap metal 6 dealer having been convicted of three separate violations of this 7 act. However, before the Tax Commission may cancel or suspend any 8 permit or refuse the issuance, reinstatement or extension thereof, 9 the Tax Commission shall give each holder of a permit or applicant 10 ten (10) days' notice of a hearing before the Tax Commission, 11 granting such person an opportunity to show cause why such action 12 should not be taken. Upon notice given to any scrap metal dealer by 13 the Tax Commission of its intention to cancel or suspend any permit 14 or to refuse the issuance, reinstatement or extension thereof, the 15 Tax Commission shall have the authority to enter its order 16 suspending such permit or prohibiting the applicant from doing 17 business without a permit pending the final hearing before it as 18 provided for in this section.

B. 1. After notice of the order of suspension or prohibition from doing business, it shall be unlawful for the scrap metal dealer to further engage in the business of a scrap metal dealer, as defined herein. In the event any such person shall conduct or at any time continue such unlawful operation, after notice of suspension or prohibition from doing business, the Tax Commission

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<sup>1</sup> may institute or cause to be brought against such person or persons <sup>2</sup> proceedings for injunction in any court of competent jurisdiction to <sup>3</sup> enjoin and restrain such person or persons from doing business <sup>4</sup> pending the order of the Tax Commission.

<sup>5</sup> 2. Upon cancellation of a permit by the Tax Commission, no new <sup>6</sup> permit shall be issued to such dealer or any firm, corporation or <sup>7</sup> other legal entity under his or her direct or indirect control or <sup>8</sup> association, for a period of one (1) year from the date of <sup>9</sup> cancellation.

In all cases where proceedings are brought for injunction under this act, no bond for injunction shall be required and in all such cases, after notice of suspension has been given, no further notice shall be required before the issuance of a temporary restraining order on any proceeding for injunction.

15 C. If an appeal is taken from the order of the Tax Commission 16 issued pursuant to this section, the scrap metal dealer, in order to 17 conduct business as a scrap metal dealer pending outcome of the 18 appeal, shall be required to post a bond in the amount of Five 19 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

2013, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 18, O.S.L. 2014, and as
22 renumbered by Section 12, Chapter 18, O.S.L. 2014 (2 O.S. Supp.
23 2020, Section 11-99), is amended to read as follows:

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Section 11-99. A. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry may suspend, cancel, revoke, or refuse reissuance of a scrap metal dealer license after the person has an opportunity for public hearing pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act for any of the following causes: 1. Engages in fraud or deceit in obtaining or renewing a

7 license;

8 2. Acts as a scrap metal dealer in this state without a 9 license;

10 3. Aids or abets another person in acting as a scrap metal 11 dealer without a license; or

Violates any of the provisions of the <u>Sergeant Craig Johnson</u>
 Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act.

14 B. After notice and opportunity for a hearing in accordance 15 with the Administrative Procedures Act, if the Department finds any 16 person in violation of the Sergeant Craig Johnson Oklahoma Scrap 17 Metal Dealers Act or any rule promulgated or order issued pursuant 18 thereto, the Department shall have the authority to assess an 19 administrative penalty of not less than One Hundred Dollars 20 (\$100.00) and not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for 21 each violation. Each action or each day a violation continues may 22 constitute a separate and distinct violation.

C. In addition to penalties and fines, the Department shall
have authority to apply to district court and obtain a temporary or

permanent injunction against anyone who violates the <u>Sergeant Craig</u> <u>Johnson</u> Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act and shall have authority to obtain or impose civil monetary penalties on anyone who violates the <u>Sergeant Craig Johnson</u> Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act.

5 Nothing in the Sergeant Craig Johnson Oklahoma Scrap Metal D. 6 Dealers Act shall preclude the Department from seeking penalties in 7 district court in the maximum amount allowed by law. The assessment 8 of penalties in an administrative enforcement proceeding shall not 9 prevent the subsequent assessment by a court of the maximum civil or 10 criminal penalties for violations of the Sergeant Craig Johnson 11 Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealers Act and rules promulgated pursuant 12 thereto.

E. Any person assessed an administrative or civil penalty may be required to pay, in addition to the penalty amount and interest thereon, attorney fees and costs associated with the collection of the penalties.

F. If any person refuses, denies or interferes with any right of access, the Department shall have the right to apply to and obtain from a district court an administrative or other warrant as necessary to enforce the right of access and inspection.

G. If the Department finds any person operating as a scrap metal dealer without a license, the Department shall have the authority to tag as "Not For Commercial Use" any weight or measure utilized by the scrap metal dealer.
