5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to public health; prohibiting
7 vaccination mandate by specified entities; providing
8 for codification; and declaring an emergency.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-502.5 of Title 63, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 A state entity, political subdivision, private entity, hospital
14 or agent thereof shall not require the receipt of a vaccine or
15 vaccines used to prevent SARS-CoV-2 or COVID-19 for any reason
16 including but not limited to as a condition of employment,
17 professional licensure, educational certification or degree,
18 admittance to any place of business or entertainment or access to
19 any mode of transportation.

20 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
