SENATE BILL 1136

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crime and punishment; amending 21 O.S. 2021, Section 650.8, which relates to felony assault, battery or assault and battery upon employee of facility; allowing for certain felony offense; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 650.8, is amended to read as follows:

Section 650.8. A. Every person who, without justifiable or excusable cause, knowingly commits any assault, battery or assault and battery upon the person of an employee of a facility maintained by the Office of Juvenile Affairs, a facility maintained by a private contractor pursuant to a contract with the Office of Juvenile Affairs primarily for delinquent children, a juvenile detention center, or a juvenile bureau, while the employee is in the performance of his duties, shall, upon conviction, ~~thereof~~ be guilty of a felony.

1       B. Every person who, without justifiable or excusable cause,  
2 knowingly commits any assault, battery or assault and battery upon  
3 the person of an employee of a facility maintained by the Department  
4 of Human Services or a facility maintained by a private contractor  
5 pursuant to a contract with the Department of Human Services, while  
6 the employee is in the performance of their duties, shall upon  
7 conviction, be guilty of a felony.

8       C. This section shall not supersede any other act or acts, but  
9 shall be cumulative thereto.

10       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
