6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to students; requiring school
8 districts and charter schools to include certain
9 information on student identification cards; allowing
10 certain information to be included on student
11 identification cards; stating legislative intent that
12 certain institutions of higher education include
13 certain information on student identification cards;
14 allowing issuance of certain non-compliant
15 identification cards until a supply is depleted;
16 providing for application; providing for
17 codification; and providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-100.10 of Title 70, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. Beginning July 1, 2023, school districts and charter schools
23 that serve any students in grades seven through twelve and issue
24 student identification cards shall have printed on either side of
the student identification cards the telephone number described in
paragraph 1 of this subsection and may have printed on either side

1 of the student identification cards the telephone number described
2 in paragraph 2 of this subsection:

3 1. The telephone number for the National Suicide Prevention
4 Lifeline; and

5 2. The Crisis Text Line, which can be accessed by texting HOME
6 to 741741.

7 B. It is the intent of the Legislature that beginning July 1,
8 2023, institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher
9 Education and private institutions of higher education in the state
10 that issue student identification cards may print on either side of
11 the student identification cards the telephone numbers described in
12 paragraphs 1, 2, and 3 of this subsection:

13 1. The telephone number for the National Suicide Prevention
14 Lifeline;

15 2. The Crisis Text Line, which can be accessed by texting HOME
16 to 741741; and

17 3. The campus police or security telephone number or, if the
18 campus does not have a campus police or security telephone number,
19 the local nonemergency telephone number.

20 C. If a school district or charter school subject to the
21 provisions of subsection A of this section or an institution of
22 higher education subject to the provisions of subsection B of this
23 section has a supply of unissued student identification cards that
24 do not comply with subsections A and B of this section, as

1 applicable, as of July 1, 2023, the school or institution of higher
2 education may issue the non-compliant student identification cards
3 until the supply is depleted.

4 D. Subsections A and B of this section shall apply to a student
5 identification card issued for the first time to a student and to a
6 student identification card issued to replace a damaged or lost
7 student identification card.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
