6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to gun control; prohibiting public
8 officers and employees from using public monies to
9 promote gun control; providing list of prohibited
actions; providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24.5 of Title 51, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A public officer or the employees of a public officer shall not
17 use public monies, or cause public monies to be used for the
18 advocacy or promotion of gun control policy and shall be
19 specifically prohibited from doing any of the following:

20 1. Using publicity or propaganda for purposes of advocating or
21 promoting gun control policy or preparing, distributing, or using
22 any kit, pamphlet, booklet, publication, electronic communication,
23 or radio, television, or video presentation designed to support or
24

1 defeat the enactment of legislation, an ordinance, rule, regulation,
2 or administrative action relating to gun control policy;

3 2. Paying the salary or expenses of any grant or contract
4 recipient or agent acting on behalf of the recipient, if the grant
5 or contract is related to any activity designed to influence the
6 enactment of legislation, an ordinance, rule, regulation, or
7 administrative action relating to gun control policy; or

8 3. Advocating or promoting any proposed, pending, or future
9 federal, state, or local tax increase relating to gun control
10 policy, or any proposed, pending, or future requirement or
11 restriction on any legal consumer product including the sale and
12 marketing of the legal consumer product relating to the advocacy or
13 promotion of gun control policy.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
