7 An Act relating to municipalities; requiring  
8 municipalities with homeless camps to conduct  
9 building inspections; stating that municipalities  
shall be liable for harm in certain areas; providing  
for codification; and providing an effective date.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 22-140 of Title 11, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 All municipalities shall have thirty (30) days to conduct  
17 inspections of homeless camps within municipal districts. The  
18 homeless camps shall be up to building codes established by the  
19 Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission. Any municipalities that  
20 do not inspect the homeless camps within the thirty-day period shall  
21 be liable for any harm within and outside of the immediate  
22 boundaries of the homeless camp. If the homeless camp does not meet  
23 building codes in the thirty-day period the municipality shall  
24 abolish the camp.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.

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
